The Stewards received a report from the Clerk of the Course, with documentary evidence attached, stating that the crew of car No. 63 stopped on SS14 on Saturday 10.6.2017 at 17:34 hrs and failed to activate the OK switch on the emergency console within one minute as stipulated in Art. 40.3.3 of the 2017 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.


The crew was then informed accordingly by the Stewards and was given the possibility, if they wished, to bring forward any representations other than having forgotten to push the button within one minute in the heat of the moment. The crew confirmed that they did not want to make any representations.

The Stewards consider that a breach of Article 40.3.3 of the 2017 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations has been committed and having further considered that Mr. Terry FOLB is a FIA priority P3 driver, after due deliberation


DECIDE
