The Stewards received a report from the Clerk of the Course, with documentary evidence attached, stating that the crew of car No. 68 stopped on special stage SS12 on Saturday 10.6.2017 at 10:55 hrs and failed to activate the OK switch on the emergency console within one minute as stipulated in Art. 40.3.3 of the 2017 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.

The crew was then informed accordingly by the Stewards and was given the possibility, if they wished, to bring forward any representations other than having forgotten to push the button within one minute in the heat of the moment.

The competitor declared that they wanted to make representations. The co-driver was then heard by the Stewards on Saturday evening at 21:45 hrs.

During the hearing he stated that when they stopped on the stage he had pressed the OK-button with his left hand. He remembered it clearly as he simultaneously, by mistake, lifted the cover of the panic button and turned the cover back down after pressing the OK-button. When the Stewards asked him whether he had checked if the green light was lit steadily for 8 seconds as expected, he admitted that he did not check the light as he hurried out of the car. The Stewards then offered the possibility to send a technician to test whether the emergency console in their car was functioning properly. The co-driver stated that he wanted to have the emergency console checked.


A technician was sent, who later confirmed that the emergency console in car No. 68 functioned properly.

The Stewards consider that a breach of Article 40.3.3 of the 2017 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations has been committed and having further considered that Mr DILLON VAN WAY is a P3 driver, after due deliberation


#### DECIDE

That the Driver DILLON VAN WAY and the Co-driver DAI ROBERTS shall be jointly and severally liable to pay a **fine of € 1,000.**
